

3RD GRADE REQUIRED SUMMER READING 2022

Research shows that children can lose up to three months of learned materials without a summer reading program. It also suggests that children who read as few as six books over the summer maintain the level of reading skills they achieved during the preceding school year. Reading more books leads to greater success.

Knoxville Christian School is requiring a summer reading program to enter into the third grade. At this grade level, students are required to read three (3) books over the summer. They will then fill out a book report form (attached) for each book.

The assignment is to be completed and returned to the teacher by Monday, August 15, 2022. These assignments will be 3 quiz grades for the second quarter. New students' assignments will be due by the first day of the second quarter, Monday October 17, 2022.
