4TH GRADE REQUIRED SUMMER READING 2023

Research shows that children can lose up to three months of learned materials without a summer reading program. It also suggests that children who read as few as six books over the summer maintain the level of reading skills they achieved during the preceding school year. Reading more books leads to greater success.

Knoxville Christian School is requiring a summer reading program to prepare students to enter into the fourth grade. At this grade level, students are required to choose from the list below and read two (2) books over the summer. They will then fill out a book report form (attached) for each book.

The assignment is to be completed and returned to the teacher by Monday, August 14, 2023. The assignment will be graded as 2 separate quiz grades for the first quarter. New students' assignments will be due by the first day of the second quarter, Monday October 16, 2023.
