4TH GRADE REQUIRED SUMMER READING 2025

Research shows that children can lose up to three months of learned materials without a summer reading program. It also suggests that children who read as few as six books over the summer maintain the level of reading skills they achieved during the preceding school year. Reading more books leads to greater success.

Knoxville Christian School is recommending a summer reading program for students entering the fourth grade with the following guidelines:

- Parents will pick the books by the grade levels on the AR Quick Search website <u>arbookfind.com</u>
- Students need to read two (2) books at grade level or higher and complete two (2) book reports in order to receive a quiz grade of 100% to start the school year.
- The book report templates are attached.

The books that will be read *in class during the school year* are

<u>The Tale of Despereaux</u> by Kate DiCamillo, <u>Prince</u>
<u>Caspian</u> by C.S. Lewis, and <u>Mrs. Frisby and the Rats of</u>
<u>NIMH</u> by Robert C. O'Brien.

NOTE: Avoid these books as summer reading content.

Book reports are due by the end of the first week of school.
