**REQUIRED SUPPLIES** for ALL MS/HS classes - Student's personal use to keep at school unless noted

- Laptop (charged) & working charging cord (*Meet technology standards posted in FACTS - "Resource Documents".*)
- College-ruled notebook paper
- #2 pencils, sharpened (Ticonderoga is preferred brand) **\*Note: pencils only in Math classes**
- Erasers
- Pens
- Ruler (*With both metric and customary units.*)
- Scissors
- Colored pencils, sharpened
- Markers
- Highlighters
- Plastic Supply Box to organize supplies
- Headphones (to use for independent work)
- Several Poster boards (*Keep at home until needed.*)
